**ORDER GRANTING DEBTOR’S APPLICATION TO EMPLOY LUCAS HORSFALL
AS ACCOUNTANT PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a), 328(a) AND 330
EFFECTIVE AS OF THE PETITION DATE**

On July 25, 2022 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the application [ECF No. 200] (“Application”) filed by Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor in possession herein (the “Debtor”), to employ Lucas Horsfall (“Lucas Horsfall”) as its accountant pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a), 328(a) and 330 effective as of the petition date. Appearances were

1 as duly noted on the record at the hearing.¹

2 The Court, having read and considered the Application and all evidence filed in support of
3 the Application including the declaration of Sameh Attia [ECF No. 259]; having further read and
4 considered the objection [ECF No. 263] to the Application filed by the United States Trustee and the
5 Debtor's reply thereto [ECF No. 279] ("Reply") and the supplemental declaration of Leslie Sobol
6 filed after the hearing on the Application [ECF No. 308] ("Sobol Decl."); the Court having
7 considered the argument and representations of counsel at the hearing and other matters which the
8 Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the record in this case as
9 reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings and conclusions on the record
10 pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of
11 Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that notice of the Application was sufficient under
12 the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; the Court having determined that the
13 legal and factual bases set forth in the Application establish just cause for the relief sought therein;
14 and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

15 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AS FOLLOWS:**

16 1. The Application is GRANTED subject to the clarifications made on the record at the
17 hearing, in the Reply and in the Sobol Decl., and as set forth in this Order.

18 2. The Debtor's employment of Luas Horsfall as its accountant is approved effective as
19 of May 24, 2022 pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 327(a), 328(a) and 330 as set forth herein.

20 3. With respect to Ordinary Course Services, the Debtor may pay Lucas Horsfall up to
21 \$5,000 a month for such Ordinary Course Services pursuant to 11 U.S.C. § 328(a) effective as of
22 May 24, 2022, without the need for a further fee application. All payments made to Lucas Horsfall
23 pursuant to this Paragraph 3 shall be disclosed on the Debtor's monthly operating reports.

24 4. With respect to the Tax Services, the Debtor's employment of Lucas Horsfall is
25 subject to 11 U.S.C. §§ 330 and 331 and Lucas Horsfall is required to file fee applications.

26 5. As set forth in the Sobol Decl., Lucas Horsfall agrees to waive its pre-petition claim

1 against the Debtor, and any scheduled or filed claim of Lucas Horsfall for such pre-petition claim
2 shall be deemed stricken upon entry of this Order.

3 6. The Court shall retain jurisdiction to hear and determine all matters arising from the
4 implementation of this Order.
