9 If you object to the relief requested, you *must* file a **WRITTEN** response to the Fee
10 Applications with the Court. You *must* also serve your written response on the person who
11 sent you this notice.

12 If you do not file a written response with the Court, or if you do not serve your written
13 response on the person who sent you this notice, then:

- 14 • The Court may *refuse to allow you to speak* at the scheduled hearing; and
- 15 • The Court may *rule against you* without formally calling the matter at the hearing.

16 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that any opposition to the Fee Applications must be
17 filed pursuant to Local Rule 9014(d)(1). **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE THAT** that if you
18 do not want the court to grant the relief sought in the Fee Applications, or if you want the court to
19 consider your views on the Fee Applications, then you must file an opposition with the court, and
20 serve a copy on the person making the Applications ***no later than 14 days*** preceding the hearing date
21 for the Fee Applications, unless an exception applies (see Local Rule 9014(d)(3)). The opposition
22 must state your position, set forth all relevant facts and legal authority, and be supported by
23 affidavits or declarations that conform to Local rule 9014(c).
