20 **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a hearing will be held on **November 18, 2022 at 9:30 a.m.**  
 21 before the Honorable August Landis, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge, in his Courtroom 1  
 22 located at 300 Las Vegas Blvd. South, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101, via ZoomGov, for the Court to  
 23 consider the *Objection to Claim of Las Vegas Development Fund, LLC* (the “Claim Objection”) filed  
 24 by Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor and debtor in possession herein (the  
 25 “Debtor”), pursuant to which the Debtor seeks entry of an order disallowing it its entirety any claim  
 26 asserted by Las Vegas Development Fund, LLC (“LVDF”) including LVDF’s Proof of Claim No.

8 If you object to the relief requested, you *must* file a **WRITTEN** response to the Claim  
9 Objection with the Court. You *must* also serve your written response on the person who sent  
10 you this notice.

11 If you do not file a written response with the Court, or if you do not serve your written  
12 response on the person who sent you this notice, then:

- 13 • The Court may *refuse to allow you to speak* at the scheduled hearing; and
- 14 • The Court may *rule against you* without formally calling the matter at the hearing.
