23 **DEBTOR’S FOURTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION (1) REDUCING AND ALLOWING**
24 **CERTAIN MEMBER CLAIMS AND (2) DISALLOWING AND EXPUNGING**
25 **CERTAIN OTHER MEMBER CLAIMS**

28 Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor in possession herein (the “Debtor”),
hereby submits its fourth omnibus objection (“Omnibus Objection”) pursuant to Section¹ 502 and
Bankruptcy Rule 3007, to the proofs of claim identified herein. The Debtor has determined that the
proofs of claim listed in the chart herein (collectively, the “Claims” and each a “Claim”) are subject

1 to reduction and/or disallowance because the amount of each of the Claims exceeds the amount paid
2 by the claimants (collectively, the “Claimants” and each a “Claimant”)² to the Debtor. Each of the
3 Claimants appears to be a member or former member of the Debtor who is asserting a Claim or
4 Claims against the estate based either on nothing or based on account of member benefits or member
5 rewards. Each Claimant apparently purchased or was given memberships to the Debtor and
6 subsequently purchased or was given membership rewards. These rewards have no value outside of
7 the Debtor’s business. While the Debtor believes that most, if not all, of the Claimants received
8 services from the Debtor at least equal to what was paid, the Debtor does not object to the Claimants
9 retaining a claim in this case for the amount each Claimant actually paid. By this Omnibus
10 Objection, the Debtor seeks to (i) disallow certain claims in their entirety and (ii) reduce the amount
11 of certain of the Claims to the amount reflected on the Debtor’s books and records as to what was
12 actually paid by the Claimants to the Debtor for their respective memberships and membership
13 rewards. Accordingly, the Debtor objects to the Claims and respectfully requests entry of an order
14 substantially in the form attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** reducing certain Claims and disallowing
15 certain Claims pursuant to section 502(b) and Bankruptcy Rules 3003 and 3007. With respect to the
16 Claims where the Debtor is seeking to reduce the amount of the Claims, to the extent any of those
17 Claimants have already voted on the Debtor’s chapter 11 plan of reorganization or do vote on the
18 plan, the Debtor is not seeking to have such vote stricken but only to have the voting amount
19 reduced to the proposed reduced Claim amount.

20 **CLAIMANTS RECEIVING THIS OMNIBUS OBJECTION SHOULD LOCATE**
21 **THEIR NAMES AND CLAIMS ON PAGES 5-6, AND 8-12.**

22 This Omnibus Objection is made and based upon the following Memorandum of Points and
23 Authorities, the declaration of Ignatius Piazza (the “Piazza Decl.”) filed in support of the Omnibus
24 Objection, the papers, pleadings, and other documents on file with the clerk of the Court, and

1 judicial notice of which is respectfully requested pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201, and such
2 other and further evidence as may be provided at the hearing on the Omnibus Objection.

3 **MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES**

4 **I. JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

5 1. This Court has jurisdiction to consider this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and
6 1334 and Local Rule 1001(b)(1).

7 2. Venue is proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.

8 3. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).

9 4. The statutory predicates for the relief sought herein are Section 11 U.S.C. §§ 105 and
10 502, Bankruptcy Rule 3007, and Local Rule 3007.

11 5. As required by Local Rule 9014.2, the Debtor consents to the entry of final orders or
12 judgments by this Court if it is determined that this Court, absent consent of the parties, cannot enter
13 final orders or judgments consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

14 **II. STATEMENT OF FACTS**

15 **A. General Case Background**

16 6. On May 24, 2022, the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of
17 the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtor continues to operate its business and manage its financial affairs
18 as a debtor in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. No trustee
19 or examiner has been appointed in this case.

20 7. On June 9, 2022, United States Trustee for Region 17 filed its *Amended Appointment*
21 *of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* [ECF No. 116].

22 **B. General History of the Debtor**

23 8. The Debtor was founded in 1996 by Ignatius Piazza. Dr. Piazza owns, either directly
24 or indirectly, 100% of the Debtor. The Debtor was originally formed as a California business and
25 operated near Bakersfield, California, from its formation in 1996 until 2002. In 1998, the Debtor
26 purchased 550 acres of raw land 45 minutes from Las Vegas, acquired approximately 500 acre feet
27

1 of water rights and began building what is now the finest and largest private firearms training facility
2 in the world (the “Front Sight Property”).

3 9. In 2012, the Debtor became a Nevada limited liability company. The Debtor’s
4 primary place of business is the Front Sight Property located at 1 Front Sight Road, Pahrump,
5 Nevada 89061, Nye County Assessor’s Parcel Nos. 045-481-05 and 045-481-06.

6 10. The Front Sight Property is accessed by a four-mile, two lane paved road, and is
7 currently comprised of 50 outdoor firearms training ranges, live fire tactical training simulators, an
8 8,000 square foot classroom and pro shop, and assorted accessory buildings, bathrooms, three water
9 wells and thousands of square yards of completed grading for future development (the “Front Sight
10 Property Facility”).

11 11. The Debtor provides firearms training courses which promote the defensive use of
12 various firearms. Courses are offered to the general public, members of law enforcement and
13 military members.

14 12. The Front Sight Firearms Facility is the most successful firearms training facility of
15 its type in the United States. The Debtor provides classes and instruction annually to upward of
16 40,000 gun and weapons enthusiasts. The Debtor is considered the leader in its field, and provides
17 additional training and instruction for numerous city and state agencies seeking to improve
18 performance of their respective law enforcement departments.

19 13. Over the last 25 years, the Debtor has trained a million students and as of the Petition
20 Date, the Debtor had over 261,000 members.

21 14. Historically, the Debtor operated its business by selling “lifetime” memberships and
22 promotional benefits such as “Front Sight Bucks,” TBD memberships, and certificates to use for
23 training courses, plus the Debtor sells ancillary products. Pre-petition, to take its business “to the
24 next level,” the Debtor developed a major expansion plan that contemplated the construction of a
25 vacation and resort development to be known as the “Front Sight Vacation Club & Resort,” to
26 include vacation residences, an RV park and related facilities, a retail area, and a pavilion. The
27 Debtor envisioned creating a self-fulfilling ecosystem, involving memberships and promotional
28

1 benefits, that would lead to an incentivized customer base that would take advantage of the club and
2 resort and other offerings to redound to the Debtor's benefit.

3 15. Ultimately, due to facts not relevant to this Omnibus Objection, the Debtor was
4 unable to expand its business, was facing a wrongful foreclosure of the Front Sight Property, and
5 sought protection under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code to restructure its business.

6 **III. RELIEF REQUESTED**

7 16. The Debtor has reviewed the proofs of claim filed in this case and has determined that
8 the following Claims are subject to reduction and/or disallowance because the amount of each of the
9 Claims exceeds the amount the Claimants paid to the Debtor for their respective membership(s) and
10 membership rewards:

17. Each of the Claimants appears to be a member or former member of the Debtor who is asserting a Claim or Claims against the estate based either on nothing or based on account of member benefits or member rewards. Each Claimant apparently purchased or was given memberships to the Debtor and subsequently purchased or was given membership rewards. These rewards have no value outside of the Debtor's business. While the Debtor believes that most, if not all, of the Claimants received services from the Debtor at least equal to what was paid, the Debtor does not object to the Claimants retaining a claim in this case for the amount each Claimant actually paid for their respective memberships and membership rewards.

18. The Debtor seeks entry of an order, pursuant to Section 502 and Bankruptcy Rule 3007, (i) disallowing certain Claims in their entirety and (ii) reducing the amount of certain of the Claims to the amount reflected on the Debtor's books and records as to what was actually paid by

1 the Claimants to the Debtor for their respective memberships and membership rewards, for the
2 reasons set forth below.

3 **IV. BASIS FOR RELIEF**

4 19. Bankruptcy Rule 3001(f) provides that a “proof of claim executed and filed in
5 accordance with these rules shall constitute prima facie evidence of the validity and amount of the
6 claim.” It is well established in the Ninth Circuit that the initial burden of persuasion for
7 establishing the validity and amount of a proof of claim is upon the claimant. *Ashford v.*
8 *Consolidated Pioneer Mortgage (In re Consolidated Pioneer Mortgage)*, 178 B.R. 222 (9th Cir.
9 BAP 1995), *aff’d*, 91 F.3d 151 (9th Cir. 1996) (a proof of claim must have a writing attached and
10 include supporting documentation to qualify for presumptive validity). However, the prima facie
11 validity of a claim does not attach unless the claim sets forth the facts necessary to support the claim.
12 *Id.* at 226.

13 20. Section 502 authorizes a “party in interest,” such as the Debtor, to object to claims.
14 11 U.S.C. § 502(a). Once the objector raises “facts tending to defeat the claim by probative force
15 equal to that of the allegations of the proofs of claim themselves,” then the burden reverts to the
16 claimant to prove the validity of the claim by a preponderance of evidence. *Wright v. Holm (In re*
17 *Holm)*, 931 F.2d 620, 623 (9th Cir. 1991); *In re Consolidated Pioneer Mortgage*, 178 B.R. at 226.
18 Indeed, the ultimate burden of persuasion is always on the claimant. *In re Holm*, 931 F.2d at 623;
19 *see also In re Heath*, 331 B.R. 424 (9th Cir. BAP 2005) (explaining that a claim that fails to attach
20 supporting documentation is not entitled to be considered as prima facie evidence of validity and
21 amount of claim).

22 21. “If the creditor does not provide information or is unable to support its claim, then
23 that in itself may raise an evidentiary basis to object to the unsupported aspects of the claim, or even
24 a basis for evidentiary sanctions, thereby coming within Section 502(b)’s grounds to disallow the
25 claim.” *In re Heath*, 331 B.R. 424, 437 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2005).

26 22. Section 502(b)(1) requires disallowance of a claim if “such claim is unenforceable
27 against the debtor and property of the debtor, under any agreement or applicable law for a reason
28

1 other than because such claim is contingent or unmatured. . .” 11 U.S.C. § 502(b)(1). The
 2 “applicable law” referenced in Section 502(b)(1) includes bankruptcy law as well as other federal
 3 and state laws. *See Cavaliere v. Sapir*, 208 B.R. 784, 786-787 (D. Conn. 1997) (providing that
 4 “applicable law” includes bankruptcy law). A debtor is therefore allowed to raise any federal or
 5 state law defenses to a claim. *See In re G.I. Industries, Inc.*, 204 F.3d 1276, 1281 (9th Cir. 2000)
 6 (stating that a claim cannot be allowed under Section 502(b)(1) if it is unenforceable under
 7 nonbankruptcy law); *Johnson v. Righetti*, 756 F.2d 738, 741 (9th Cir. 1985) (finding that the validity
 8 of the claim may be determined under state law); *In re Eastview Estates II*, 713 F.2d 443, 447 (9th
 9 Cir. 1983) (applying California law).

10 V. OBJECTIONS TO CLAIMS

11 23. First, many of the Claims are not entitled to prima facie validity because the Claims
 12 do not contain sufficient evidence to support the amount of the Claim. Many of the Claims are
 13 essentially “face page” proofs of claim that do not set forth the facts necessary to support the amount
 14 of the Claims though some of them do have attachments. The Claims do not include a sufficient
 15 accounting of the amounts paid by Claimants to the Debtor for their memberships and membership
 16 rewards. The burden of persuasion for establishing the validity and amount of a Claim is on the
 17 Claimant, and the Claimants have failed to meet their burden. Consequently, the Court should
 18 sustain the Omnibus Objection.

19 24. Second, the Claims should be reduced to the amount that the respective Claimant paid
 20 to the Debtor for their membership and membership rewards. Specifically, the Debtor’s books and
 21 records show that the Claimants paid the following amounts to the Debtor for their membership and
 22 membership rewards:

25. Accordingly, the Debtor objects to the Claims because the Claims exceed the amount the Claimants paid to the Debtor and requests that the Court reduce the Claims to the amount each Claimant paid to the Debtor for their membership and membership rewards (or disallow the Claims to the extent that the member has not paid anything to the Debtor).

26. Third, Claim No. 631-1 states that a portion of the Claim is entitled to priority status under Section 507(a)(7). However, deposits for memberships are not entitled to priority status under Section 507(a)(7). *In re Palmas del Mar Country Club, Inc.*, 443 B.R. 569, 575 (Bankr. D.P.R. 2010) (disallowing priority claims filed by the country club's members for refund of the membership deposit and allowing the claims as general unsecured claims). Accordingly, to the extent that Claim No. 631-1 is allowed in any amount, the claim is not entitled to priority and should be classified as a general unsecured claim.

27. Fourth, the Debtor's books and records reflect that several of the Claimants did not pay any amounts to Debtor for their membership or member benefits. Accordingly, the Debtor requests that those Claims be disallowed in their entirety.

28. Fifth, the Debtor's books and records reflect that the Debtor refunded \$2,534.00 to Claimant Myron K. Wiley after his membership was terminated, i.e., the Debtor refunded Mr. Wiley the total amount of money that Mr. Wiley paid to the Debtor for his membership and membership benefits. Accordingly, Mr. Wiley is not entitled to any claim against the Debtor or its estate and Claim No. 712-1 should be disallowed in its entirety.

29. Accordingly, the Debtor respectfully requests that the Court reduce the following Claims and allow the Claims as general unsecured claims as set forth below:

The Debtor specifically reserves the right to amend this Omnibus Objection, file additional papers in support of this Omnibus Objection or take other appropriate actions, including, *inter alia*, to: (a) respond to any allegation or defense that may be raised in a response filed by or on behalf of any of the Claimants or other interested parties; (b) object further to any Claim for which a Claimant provides (or attempts to provide) additional documentation or substantiation; and (c) object further to any of the Claims addressed herein based on additional information that may be discovered upon further review by the Debtor or through discovery pursuant to the Bankruptcy Rules.

VII. SEPARATE CONTESTED MATTERS

32. Each of the Claims and the Debtor's objections thereto constitute a separate contested matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rules 3007 and 9014 and Local Rule 3007. The Debtor requests that any order entered by the Court with respect to a particular Claim objected to in this Omnibus Objection be deemed a separate order with respect to each Claim in accordance with Bankruptcy Rule 3007(1).

1 **VIII. NOTICE**

2 33. The Debtor will serve copies of this Omnibus Objection upon each of the Claimants
3 identified in the chart contained herein at the addresses listed on the disputed Claims, as filed.

4 **IX. CONCLUSION**

5 The Debtor respectfully request that the Court enter an order, substantially in the form
6 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** reducing certain claims and disallowing other Claims (and expunging
7 them from the Court’s docket), and granting such other and further relief as the Court may deem
8 proper and just under the circumstances.
