**ORDER SUSTAINING DEBTOR’S SECOND OMNIBUS OBJECTION AND (1)
REDUCING AND ALLOWING CERTAIN MEMBER CLAIMS AND (2) DISALLOWING
AND EXPUNGING CERTAIN OTHER MEMBER CLAIMS**

On November 18, 2022 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,
Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the
Debtor’s Second Omnibus Objection (1) Reducing and Allowing Certain Members Claims and (2)

1 *Disallowing and Expunging Certain Other Member Claims* [ECF No. 426] (the “Omnibus
2 Objection”)¹ filed by Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the “Debtor”).
3 Appearances were as duly noted on the record at the hearing.

4 The Court, having read and considered the Omnibus Objection and all evidence filed in
5 support of the Omnibus Objection; the Court having considered the argument and representations of
6 counsel at the hearing and other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice,
7 including, without limitation, the record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set
8 forth its findings and conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil
9 Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure which findings and
10 conclusions of law are incorporated herein by this reference; the Court having found that notice of
11 the Omnibus Objection was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is
12 required; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Omnibus
13 Objection establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after due deliberation and sufficient
14 cause appearing therefor,

15 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Omnibus Objection is sustained, except as to the
16 objection to Claim 244-1 filed by Claimant David Streck because the Debtor withdrew its objection
17 prior to the hearing on the Omnibus Objection [ECF No. 462].

18 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the following Proofs of Claim shall be
