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Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the *Amended Fourth Omnibus Objection (1) Reducing and Allowing Certain Members Claims and (2) Disallowing and Expunging Certain Other Member Claims* [ECF No. 480] (the "Omnibus Objection")¹ filed by Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the "Debtor"). The Court, having read and considered the Omnibus Objection and all evidence filed in support of the Omnibus Objection; the Court having considered the argument and representations of counsel at the hearing and other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings and conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that notice of the Omnibus Objection was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Omnibus Objection establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Omnibus Objection is sustained in its entirety.
