**ORDER SUSTAINING SEVENTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO PROOFS OF CLAIM
THAT ASSERT AN INCORRECT PRIORITY**

On January 9, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,
Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the

1 *Seventh Omnibus Objection to Proofs of Claim that Assert an Incorrect Priority* [ECF No. 563] (the
 2 “Omnibus Objection”)¹ filed by Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the
 3 “Debtor”). Pursuant to the Debtor’s confirmed chapter 11 plan of reorganization and order thereon,
 4 Province, LLC, solely in its capacity as the Liquidating Trustee of the Front Sight Creditors Trust
 5 (the “Liquidating Trust”), has standing to pursue the Omnibus Objection. Appearances were as duly
 6 noted on the record at the hearing.

7 The Court, having read and considered the Omnibus Objection and all evidence filed in
 8 support of the Omnibus Objection; the Court having considered the argument and representations of
 9 counsel at the hearing and other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice,
 10 including, without limitation, the record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set
 11 forth its findings and conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil
 12 Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that
 13 notice of the Omnibus Objection was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further
 14 notice is required; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the
 15 Omnibus Objection establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after due deliberation and
 16 sufficient cause appearing therefor,

17 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Omnibus Objection is sustained in its entirety.

18 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the following Proofs of Claim filed by the
 19 following claimants (“Claimants”) shall be RECLASSIFIED as GENERAL UNSECURED
 20 CLAIMS:
