21	Court grant Front Sight leave pursuant to LR 9014(e)(i) for an extension of the applicable page	
22	limit for its Omnibus Opposition to: (I) Motion for Clarification and/or Motion for	
23	Reconsideration [AECF No. 141]; and (II) Motion to Allow Amendment to Proof of Claim [ECI	
24	No. 665] (the "Omnibus Opposition").	
25	Good cause exists to extend the page limitation for the Omnibus Opposition as Front Sigh	
26	is responding to two separate motions filed by Las Vegas Development Fund, LLC ("LVDF"): (i	
27	Motion to Allow Amendment to Proof of Claim [ECF No. 665]; and (ii) Motion for Clarification
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and/or Motion for Reconsideration [AECF No. 141]. Front Sight submits that filing an omnibus opposition is prudent because of the significant factual and legal overlap between LVDF's two separate motions. Front Sight anticipates that its Omnibus Opposition will not exceed twenty-seven (27) pages in length, which is less than the forty pages Front Sight would be afforded if it filed two separate oppositions. Thus, Front Sight respectfully requests that the Court extend the permissible page limit up and including twenty-seven (27) pages.

WHEREFORE, Front Sight respectfully request that the Court enter an order granting Front Sight leave pursuant to LR 9014(e)(i) to file the Omnibus Opposition up to and including twenty-seven (27) pages in length.
