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21 **DEBTOR’S SEVENTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION TO PROOFS OF CLAIM THAT**  
 22 **ASSERT AN INCORRECT PRIORITY**

25 Front Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the “Debtor”), hereby submits  
 26 its first omnibus objection (“Omnibus Objection”) pursuant to Section<sup>1</sup> 502 and Bankruptcy Rule  
 27 3007, to the proofs of claim identified herein. After careful review, the Debtor has determined that  
 28 the proofs of claim listed in the chart herein (each a “Claim” and collectively, the “Incorrect Priority

1 Claims”) filed by the claimants (collectively, the “Claimants” and each a “Claimant”)<sup>2</sup> assert an  
2 incorrect priority under Section 507. The Debtor objects to the Incorrect Priority Claims because  
3 they (i) incorrectly assert priority and/or (ii) assert priority in an amount that exceeds the statutory  
4 limit allowed pursuant to Section 507. Accordingly, the Debtor objects to the Incorrect Priority  
5 Claims and respectfully requests entry of an order substantially in the form attached hereto as  
6 **Exhibit 2** sustaining this Omnibus Objection and reclassifying the Incorrect Priority Claims as  
7 general unsecured claims.

8 **CLAIMANTS RECEIVING THIS OMNIBUS OBJECTION SHOULD LOCATE**  
9 **THEIR NAMES AND CLAIMS ON PAGES 4-6.**

10 This Omnibus Objection is made and based upon the following Memorandum of Points and  
11 Authorities, the Omnibus Declaration of Ignatius Piazza (the “Piazza Decl.”) filed in support of the  
12 Omnibus Objection, the papers, pleadings, and other documents on file with the clerk of the Court,  
13 and judicial notice of which is respectfully requested pursuant to Federal Rule of Evidence 201, and  
14 such other and further evidence as may be provided at the hearing on the Omnibus Objection.

15 **MEMORANDUM OF POINTS AND AUTHORITIES**

16 **I. JURISDICTION AND VENUE**

- 17 1. This Court has jurisdiction to consider this matter pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 157 and  
18 1334 and Local Rule 1001(b)(1).
- 19 2. Venue is proper before this Court pursuant to 28 U.S.C. §§ 1408 and 1409.
- 20 3. This is a core proceeding pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 157(b)(2).
- 21 4. The statutory predicates for the relief sought herein are Section 11 U.S.C. §§ 105 and  
22 502, Bankruptcy Rule 3007, and Local Rule 3007.
- 23 5. As required by Local Rule 9014.2, the Debtor consents to the entry of final orders or  
24 judgments by this Court if it is determined that this Court, absent consent of the parties, cannot enter  
25 final orders or judgments consistent with Article III of the United States Constitution.

1 **II. STATEMENT OF FACTS**

2 **A. General Case Background**

3 6. On May 24, 2022, the Debtor filed a voluntary petition for relief under chapter 11 of  
4 the Bankruptcy Code. The Debtor continues to operate its business and manage its financial affairs  
5 as a debtor in possession pursuant to sections 1107(a) and 1108 of the Bankruptcy Code. No trustee  
6 or examiner has been appointed in this case.

7 7. On June 9, 2022, United States Trustee for Region 17 filed its *Amended Appointment*  
8 *of the Official Committee of Unsecured Creditors* [ECF No. 116].

9 **B. General History of the Debtor**

10 8. The Debtor was founded in 1996 by Ignatius Piazza. Dr. Piazza owns, either directly  
11 or indirectly, 100% of the Debtor. The Debtor was originally formed as a California business and  
12 operated near Bakersfield, California, from its formation in 1996 until 2002. In 1998, the Debtor  
13 purchased 550 acres of raw land 45 minutes from Las Vegas, acquired approximately 500 acre feet  
14 of water rights and began building what is now the finest and largest private firearms training facility  
15 in the world (the “Front Sight Property”).

16 9. In 2012, the Debtor became a Nevada limited liability company. The Debtor’s  
17 primary place of business is the Front Sight Property located at 1 Front Sight Road, Pahrump,  
18 Nevada 89061, Nye County Assessor’s Parcel Nos. 045-481-05 and 045-481-06.

19 10. The Front Sight Property is accessed by a four-mile, two lane paved road, and is  
20 currently comprised of 50 outdoor firearms training ranges, live fire tactical training simulators, an  
21 8,000 square foot classroom and pro shop, and assorted accessory buildings, bathrooms, three water  
22 wells and thousands of square yards of completed grading for future development (the “Front Sight  
23 Property Facility”).

24 11. Historically, the Debtor provided firearms training courses which promoted the  
25 defensive use of various firearms. Courses were offered to the general public, members of law  
26 enforcement and military members.

27 12. Historically, the Debtor operated its business by selling “lifetime” memberships and  
28 promotional benefits such as “Front Sight Bucks,” TBD memberships, and certificates to use for

1 training courses, plus the Debtor sells ancillary products. Pre-petition, to take its business “to the  
 2 next level,” the Debtor developed a major expansion plan that contemplated the construction of a  
 3 vacation and resort development to be known as the “Front Sight Vacation Club & Resort,” to  
 4 include vacation residences, an RV park and related facilities, a retail area, and a pavilion. The  
 5 Debtor envisioned creating a self-fulfilling ecosystem, involving memberships and promotional  
 6 benefits, that would lead to an incentivized customer base that would take advantage of the club and  
 7 resort and other offerings to redound to the Debtor’s benefit.

8 13. Ultimately, due to facts not relevant to this Omnibus Objection, the Debtor was  
 9 unable to expand its business, was facing a wrongful foreclosure of the Front Sight Property, and  
 10 sought protection under chapter 11 of the Bankruptcy Code to restructure its business.

11 14. On November 29, 2022, the order confirming the Debtor’s second amended chapter  
 12 11 plan of reorganization was entered [ECF No. 556] (the “Conformation Order”) pursuant to which  
 13 the “Reorganized Debtor” will have new ownership and membership on the “effective date” of the  
 14 plan. The Debtor expects the effective date to be December 1, 2022.

15 15. Pursuant to the Confirmation Order, a liquidating trust (“Trust”) will be created to,  
 16 among other things, oversee and administer general unsecured claims, objections thereto, and  
 17 ultimately distributions on allowed claims. Amanda Demby of Province, LLC will be the liquidating  
 18 trustee of the Trust and will take over as the party in interest to all pending claim objections,  
 19 including this Omnibus Objection.

### 20 **III. RELIEF REQUESTED**

21 16. The Debtor has reviewed the Claims Register and the proofs of claim filed in this  
 22 case and has determined that the Incorrect Priority Claims identified in the chart below do not assert  
 23 the correct priority. Claimants receiving this Omnibus Objection should locate their names and  
 24 claims below.

17. The Debtor objects to the Incorrect Priority Claims because they (i) incorrectly assert priority under Section 507(a)(7) and/or (ii) assert priority in an amount that exceeds the statutory limit allowed pursuant to Section 507(a)(7). Accordingly, the Debtor requests that each of the Incorrect Priority Claims listed above be reclassified as general unsecured claims.

#### IV. BASIS FOR RELIEF

##### A. Standard for Disallowance of Proofs of Claims

18. Bankruptcy Rule 3001(f) provides that a “proof of claim executed and filed in accordance with these rules shall constitute prima facie evidence of the validity and amount of the claim.” It is well established in the Ninth Circuit that the initial burden of persuasion for establishing the validity and amount of a proof of claim is upon the claimant. *Ashford v. Consolidated Pioneer Mortgage (In re Consolidated Pioneer Mortgage)*, 178 B.R. 222 (9th Cir. BAP 1995), *aff’d*, 91 F.3d 151 (9th Cir. 1996) (a proof of claim must have a writing attached and include supporting documentation to qualify for presumptive validity). However, the prima facie validity of a claim does not attach unless the claim sets forth the facts necessary to support the claim. *Id.* at 226.

19. Section 502 authorizes a “party in interest,” such as the Debtor, to object to claims. 11 U.S.C. § 502(a). Once the objector raises “facts tending to defeat the claim by probative force equal to that of the allegations of the proofs of claim themselves,” then the burden reverts to the claimant to prove the validity of the claim by a preponderance of evidence. *Wright v. Holm (In re Holm)*, 931 F.2d 620, 623 (9th Cir. 1991); *In re Consolidated Pioneer Mortgage*, 178 B.R. at 226. Indeed, the ultimate burden of persuasion is always on the claimant. *In re Holm*, 931 F.2d at 623;

1 *see also In re Heath*, 331 B.R. 424 (9th Cir. BAP 2005) (explaining that a claim that fails to attach  
2 supporting documentation is not entitled to be considered as prima facie evidence of validity and  
3 amount of claim).

4 20. “If the creditor does not provide information or is unable to support its claim, then  
5 that in itself may raise an evidentiary basis to object to the unsupported aspects of the claim, or even  
6 a basis for evidentiary sanctions, thereby coming within Section 502(b)’s grounds to disallow the  
7 claim.” *In re Heath*, 331 B.R. 424, 437 (B.A.P. 9th Cir. 2005).

8 21. Section 502(b)(1) requires disallowance of a claim if “such claim is unenforceable  
9 against the debtor and property of the debtor, under any agreement or applicable law for a reason  
10 other than because such claim is contingent or unmatured. . .” 11 U.S.C. § 502(b)(1). The  
11 “applicable law” referenced in Section 502(b)(1) includes bankruptcy law as well as other federal  
12 and state laws. *See Cavaliere v. Sapir*, 208 B.R. 784, 786-787 (D. Conn. 1997) (providing that  
13 “applicable law” includes bankruptcy law). A debtor is therefore allowed to raise any federal or  
14 state law defenses to a claim. *See In re G.I. Industries, Inc.*, 204 F.3d 1276, 1281 (9th Cir. 2000)  
15 (stating that a claim cannot be allowed under Section 502(b)(1) if it is unenforceable under  
16 nonbankruptcy law); *Johnson v. Righetti*, 756 F.2d 738, 741 (9th Cir. 1985) (finding that the validity  
17 of the claim may be determined under state law); *In re Eastview Estates II*, 713 F.2d 443, 447 (9th  
18 Cir. 1983) (applying California law).

19 **B. The Incorrect Priority Claims are Not Entitled to Priority and Should Be**  
20 **Reclassified as General Unsecured Claims**

21 22. Each of the Claimants appears to be a member or former member of the Debtor who  
22 is asserting a claim against the estate based on account of amounts paid for the Claimants’  
23 memberships and member rewards. Each Claimant apparently purchased or was given memberships  
24 to the Debtor and subsequently purchased or was given membership rewards. These rewards have  
25 no value outside of the Debtor’s business. While the Debtor believes that most, if not all, of the  
26 Claimants received services from the Debtor at least equal to what was paid, the Debtor does not  
27 object to the Claimants retaining a claim in this case for the amount each Claimant actually paid.  
28

1           23.     The Incorrect Priority Claims assert that all or a portion of each Claim is entitled to  
2 priority under Section 507(a)(7). Section 507(a)(7) provides priority for:

3                   allowed unsecured claims of individuals, to the extent of [\$3,350] for  
4                   each such individual, arising from the deposit, before the  
5                   commencement of the case, of money in connection with the purchase,  
6                   lease, or rental of property, or the purchase of services, for the  
7                   personal, family, or household use of such individuals, that were not  
8                   delivered or provided.

9           11 U.S.C. § 507(a)(7).

10           24.     Bankruptcy courts routinely find that claims based on amounts paid for memberships  
11 are not entitled to priority. For example, in *In re Four Star Financial Services, LLC* (“*Four Star*”),  
12 469 B.R. 30 (C.D. Cal. 2012), the claimant paid an initiation fee to purchase a transferable lifetime  
13 membership which entitled the member to use various campgrounds for life. On average, the  
14 initiation fee was \$4,500 plus annual dues. *Id.* at 31. The claimant argued he was entitled to a  
15 priority claim and that “he contracted for a transferable, lifetime membership, and the services that  
16 go with it, and at the time of the bankruptcy he had not yet received all these services.” *Id.* at 33.

17           25.     In *Four Star*, the district court noted that “the initiation fee paid here by Appellee  
18 entitled him to immediate use of the campground network. With the payment of the initiation fee,  
19 Appellee was immediately a member. He was not waiting for services to be rendered by TAI.  
20 Somewhat illogically, Appellee points to his lifetime membership and transferability as evidence of  
21 undelivered services. Assuming this were true, Appellee's bargained-for services would not be  
22 delivered for several generations. While not discounting the premium placed on the longevity and  
23 transferability of the memberships, the Court finds these benefits inherent in the membership  
24 Appellee received immediately, rather than something incapable of delivery for several generations  
25 ... Appellee paid an initiation fee and was immediately entitled to avail himself of the entire  
26 campground network. Appellee contracted with his eyes wide open, and while he might not have  
27 foreseen the financial trouble of TAI, this was a risk he took in signing up to be a member of the  
28 campground network.” *Id.* at 35.



1           26.     The *Four Star* district court ultimately found that “the initiation fee entitled Appellee  
2 to the immediate use of the facilities. The initiation fee was not paid for the future guarantee of  
3 services and monthly dues were required in order to continue utilizing the campground network ...  
4 In neither case was the initiation fee offered as security for the future provision of services; it was  
5 merely the price of admission. Thus, the initiation fee was not a deposit and the bankruptcy court  
6 erred by giving Appellee’s Claim priority...” *Id.*

7           27.     Likewise, *In re Palmas del Mar Country Club, Inc. (“Palmas”)*, 443 B.R. 569  
8 (Bankr. D. P.R. 2010), the debtor objected to priority claims asserted by former members of its  
9 country club for refund of their up-front payments. In its analysis, the district court noted that the  
10 “rights of such Claimants were fully vested upon payment of the Membership Deposit because upon  
11 such payment they became club members, which was what the Membership Deposit made them  
12 entitled to. The up-front payments provided by the club members were for an immediate service  
13 which was provided, and not for a future right to buy, lease or rent any property. The rights and  
14 responsibilities of the Debtor were both fully operative and were being delivered and provided prior  
15 to the filing of the bankruptcy petition.” *Id.* at 575. The *Palmas* court found that the claims filed by  
16 the debtor’s members for refund of the membership deposit were not entitled to priority under  
17 Section 507(a)(7).

18           28.     Here, as in *Four Star* and *Palmas*, with the payment of the membership fee, each  
19 Claimant was immediately a member of the Debtor and was entitled to immediate use of the  
20 Debtor’s facilities. The up-front payments provided by the Claimants were for an immediate  
21 service, which was provided to the Claimants, i.e., to become members of the Debtor, and not for a  
22 future right to buy, lease or rent any property. Accordingly, the up-front payments made by the  
23 Claimants for their memberships and member rewards are not deposits under Section 507(a)(7), and  
24 therefore the Incorrect Priority Claims are not entitled to priority.

25           29.     The Debtor respectfully requests that the Court sustain this Omnibus Objection and  
26 reclassify the Incorrect Priority Claims as general unsecured claims.

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1           **C.     The Standards Governing Omnibus Objections to Claims Have Been Met**

2           30.     Bankruptcy Rule 3007(d)(7), (8) and (e) govern omnibus objections to proofs of  
3 claim that assert an incorrect priority. Bankruptcy Rule 3007(d)(7) and (8) specifically allows for  
4 omnibus objections to claims if “they assert interests, rather than claims” or “asserts priority in an  
5 amount” that exceeds the statutory limit. Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007(d)(7) and (8). The requirements for  
6 omnibus objections are contained in Bankruptcy Rule 3007(e), which provides that such objections  
7 shall:

- 8
- 9                     (1) state in a conspicuous place that claimants receiving the  
10 objection should locate their names and claims in the objection; (2)  
11 list claimants alphabetically, provide a cross-reference to claim  
12 numbers, and, if appropriate, list claimants by category of claims;  
13 (3) state the grounds of the objection to each claim and provide a  
14 cross-reference to the pages in the omnibus objection pertinent to  
15 the stated grounds; (4) state in the title the identity of the objector  
16 and the grounds for the objections; (5) be numbered consecutively  
17 with other omnibus objections filed by the same objector; and (6)  
18 contain objections to no more than 100 claims.

15 Fed. R. Bankr. P. 3007(e).

16           31.     This Omnibus Objection falls within the grounds set forth in Bankruptcy Rule  
17 3007(d)(1). Furthermore, each of the requirements set forth in Bankruptcy Rule 3007(e) have been  
18 complied with or will be complied with upon the filing of this Omnibus Objection. Therefore, this  
19 Omnibus Objection should be sustained.

20           **V.     RESERVATION OF RIGHTS**

21           32.     The Debtor specifically reserves the right to amend this Omnibus Objection, file  
22 additional papers in support of this Omnibus Objection or take other appropriate actions, including,  
23 *inter alia*, to: (a) respond to any allegation or defense that may be raised in a response filed by or on  
24 behalf of any of the Claimants or other interested parties; (b) object further to any Claim for which a  
25 Claimant provides (or attempts to provide) additional documentation or substantiation; and (c) object  
26 further to any of the Claims addressed herein based on additional information that may be  
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1 discovered upon further review by the Debtor or through discovery pursuant to the Bankruptcy  
2 Rules.

3 **VI. SEPARATE CONTESTED MATTERS**

4 33. Each of the Claims and the Debtor's objections thereto constitute a separate contested  
5 matter as contemplated by Bankruptcy Rules 3007 and 9014 and Local Rule 3007. The Debtor  
6 requests that any order entered by the Court with respect to a particular Claim objected to in this  
7 Omnibus Objection be deemed a separate order with respect to each Claim in accordance with  
8 Bankruptcy Rule 3007(1).

9 **VII. NOTICE**

10 34. The Debtor will serve copies of this Omnibus Objection upon each of the Claimants  
11 identified in the chart contained herein at the addresses listed on the disputed Claims, as filed.

12 **VIII. CONCLUSION**

13 The Debtor respectfully requests that the Court enter an order, substantially in the form  
14 attached hereto as **Exhibit 2** sustaining the Omnibus Objection and reclassifying the Incorrect  
15 Priority Claims as general unsecured claims, and granting such other and further relief as the Court  
16 may deem proper and just under the circumstances.

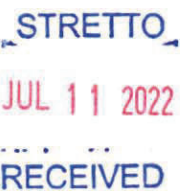
