Pursuant to the Debtor's confirmed chapter 11 plan of reorganization and order thereon, Province, LLC, solely in its capacity as the Liquidating Trustee ("Liquidating Trustee") of the Front Sight Creditors Trust ("Liquidating Trust"), has standing to pursue the Omnibus Objection. Appearances were as duly noted on the record at the hearing.

The Court, having read and considered the Omnibus Objection and all evidence filed in support of the Omnibus Objection; the Court having considered the response [ECF No. 530] (the "Stringham Response") filed by claimant Ward Stringham; the Court having considered the reply [ECF No. 630] filed by the Liquidating Trustee to the Stringham Response; the Court having considered the argument and representations of counsel at the hearing and other matters which the Court may properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the record in this case as reflected on the docket; the Court having set forth its findings and conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure; the Court having found that notice of the Omnibus Objection was sufficient under the circumstances and no other or further notice is required; the Court having determined that the legal and factual bases set forth in the Omnibus Objection establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

IT IS HEREBY ORDERED that the Omnibus Objection is sustained except as modified by this Order.
