**ORDER SUSTAINING FIFTH OMNIBUS OBJECTION AND (1) REDUCING AND
ALLOWING CERTAIN MEMBER CLAIMS AND (2) DISALLOWING
AND EXPUNGING CERTAIN OTHER MEMBER CLAIMS**

On January 9, 2023 at 9:30 a.m., a hearing was held before the Honorable August Landis,
Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge for the District of Nevada, for the Court to consider the *Fifth*

1 *Omnibus Objection (1) Reducing and Allowing Certain Members Claims and (2) Disallowing and*
2 *Expunging Certain Other Member Claims* [ECF No. 558] (the “Omnibus Objection”)¹ filed by Front
3 Sight Management LLC, the chapter 11 debtor herein (the “Debtor”). Pursuant to the Debtor’s
4 confirmed chapter 11 plan of reorganization and order thereon, Province, LLC, solely in its capacity
5 as the Liquidating Trustee (“Liquidating Trustee”) of the Front Sight Creditors Trust (“Liquidating
6 Trust”), has standing to pursue the Omnibus Objection. Appearances were as duly noted on the
7 record at the hearing.

8 The Court, having read and considered the Omnibus Objection and all evidence filed in
9 support of the Omnibus Objection; the Court having considered the response to the Omnibus
10 Objection filed by claimant James Dutton [ECF No. 610] (the “Dutton Response”); the Court having
11 considered the response to the Omnibus Objection filed by by claimant Glenn Roberts [ECF No.
12 633, Exh. 1] (the “Roberts Response”); the Court having considered the reply [ECF No. 632] to the
13 Dutton Response filed by the Liquidating Trustee; the Court having considered the reply [ECF No.
14 633] to the Roberts Response filed by the Liquidating Trustee; the Court having considered the
15 argument and representations of counsel at the hearing and other matters which the Court may
16 properly take judicial notice, including, without limitation, the record in this case as reflected on the
17 docket; the Court having set forth its findings and conclusions on the record pursuant to Rule 52 of
18 the Federal Rules of Civil Procedure and Rule 7052 of the Federal Rules of Bankruptcy Procedure;
19 the Court having found that notice of the Omnibus Objection was sufficient under the circumstances
20 and no other or further notice is required; the Court having determined that the legal and factual
21 bases set forth in the Omnibus Objection establish just cause for the relief sought therein; and after
22 due deliberation and sufficient cause appearing therefor,

23 **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED** that the Omnibus Objection is sustained in its entirety.

24 **IT IS HEREBY FURTHER ORDERED** that the following Proofs of Claim shall be
25 allowed as GENERAL UNSECURED CLAIMS in the amounts set forth below in the column titled
26 “Allowed General Unsecured Claim Amount” as follows:
