 23 **ORDER EXTENDING THE CLAIM OBJECTION DEADLINE TO NOVEMBER 27, 2023**

24 **PLEASE TAKE NOTICE** that a hearing will be held on **September 26, 2023 at 1:30 p.m.**
 25 before the Honorable August Landis, Chief United States Bankruptcy Judge, in his Courtroom 1
 26 located at 300 Las Vegas Blvd. South, Las Vegas, Nevada 89101, via ZoomGov, for the Court to
 27 consider the *Liquidating Trustee’s Motion Trustee for Entry of an Order Extending the Claims*
 28 *Objection Deadline to November 27, 2023* [ECF No. 850] (the “Motion”) filed by Province, LLC,
 solely in its capacity as the duly authorized and acting Liquidating Trustee (the “Liquidating

1 Trustee”)¹ of the Front Sight Creditors Trust, pursuant to which the Liquidating Trustee seeks entry
2 of an order under Section 105(a),² Bankruptcy Rule 9006(b), and Local Rule 3007.1 extending the
3 general claims objection deadline of August 28, 2023, for approximately ninety (90) days through
4 and including November 27, 2023. Hearing information is available at

6 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that copies of the Motion and the supporting
7 declaration of Amanda Demby Swift may be obtained from the Court, located at the Foley Federal

9 filing system (<https://ecf.nvb.uscourts.gov/>), for free at the Debtor’s noticing agent’s website
10 <https://cases.stretto.com/FrontSight> or by sending a written request to counsel for the Liquidating
11 Trustee, Susan K. Seflin, via email at sseflin@bg.law.

12 **PLEASE TAKE FURTHER NOTICE** that, pursuant to Local Rule 9014(d)(1), any
13 opposition or response to the Motion (i) must set forth all relevant facts and any relevant legal
14 authority, (ii) must be supported by affidavits or declarations that conform to the provisions of Local
15 Rule 9014(c), and (iii) must be filed with the Court no later than **14 days before the hearing, i.e. by**
16 **September 12, 2023.**

17 **NOTICE IS FURTHER GIVEN** that if you do not want the Court to grant the relief sought
18 in the Motion, or if you want the Court to consider your views on the Motion, then you must file an
19 opposition with the Court, and serve a copy on the person making the Motion **no later than 14 days**
20 preceding the hearing date for the Motion, unless an exception applies (*see* Local Rule 9014(d)(3)).
